AutoCAD uses a high-level language known as Microware Macro Assembler (MMASM). It is a derivative of the Macro Assembler (MASM) computer programming language originally developed by Dan Bricklin and Bob Frankston in 1979. AutoCAD also supports many other formats and file types, such as DWG, DXF, PostScript, Revit, and PLT. Some notable features of AutoCAD: CAD is the world's most widely used CAD software, used for designing everything from consumer products to bridges and skyscrapers. Here is a simplified version of my template: `{{#view App.TableRowView content=content as | row| row=row class=row.class}} {{row.title}} {{/view}}` And here is my didInsertElement function in the view: `didInsertElement: function() { console.log("Inserting the component in DOM..."); console.log(this.get('content')); this.render(); }` I have tried a few variations of how I pass in the content object.

Currently, I am doing this: `didInsertElement: function() { this.set('content', this.get('model')); this.render(); }` Which throws this error in the console: `Uncaught TypeError: Cannot read property 'title' of undefined` Any thoughts? A: Ok, so it's a bit complicated, so I'll try and break it down. I'm using the ember grommet starter template, which means the basic Ember routing and the Ember a1d647c40b

Q: AngularJS dynamic routing I am using the AngularJS dynamic routing plugin, and I am a bit confused with the default behavior. I have two controllers: "Index" and "Search". I can dynamically change between the two controllers by: `$route.reload()`; Is there a way to dynamically specify the controllers name to route to? Ideally I would want to do something like: `$route.path(['Search'], Search)`; or `$route.path(['Index'], Index)`; A: You can try this: `$routeProvider.when("/search", { templateUrl: "search.html", controller: "SearchController", controllerAs: "searchCtrl"`
